Fee Increment and Deferral of the Increase from 4.5 to 6 Hours of ECPD for 2023/2024

Fee Increment

Since the financial year 2019/2020, the Institute's annual subscription and renewal fees have remained unchanged. During the pandemic period, the Institute provided members, graduates and students a 10% discount on annual subscriptions, renewal fees as well as on ECPD seminars.

Starting from 2023/2024, the Institute's Council has resolved to adjust the annual subscriptions, renewal fees and election fees for members, graduates and students. The Institute is pleased to note that our members and graduates continue to maintain a high governance standard by attending the Institute's ECPD seminars. To provide more flexibility for members and graduates to fulfil their CPD requirements, the Council resolved to defer the requirement of 6 ECPD hours for one year until 2024/2025.
