**Overview**  
The Institute is a recognised thought leader in governance reporting. Obtaining the Institute's ESG Reporting Certification means you stand apart from your peers by having a comprehensive ESG reporting understanding and competencies. This Course consists of seven 2-hour sessions with 20 ESG experts as speakers, including reporting professionals from listed companies, largest accounting firms and consultants.

**A Certificate that Matters**  
Attendees of the ESG Reporting Certification Course who successfully fulfilled attendance requirements and passed a final assessment will be accredited for two years and will also be:

- Permitted to use the post-nominal 'HKCGI Cert: ESG' during the accreditation period
- The names and job-titles of those who have successfully obtained the certification will be listed on the Institute's designated webpage for prospective employers and public searches.

There will be a maximum of two intakes per year and a refresher course every two years for extended accreditation. The ESG Reporting Certification Course counts toward ECPD hours for Institute members.

- Introduction to HKEV's ESG Reporting Guide
- Directors' duties in ESG & climate reporting
- ESG and climate-related disclosures
- Setting metrics and targets
- Setting strategy, materiality assessment, and identifying risks and opportunities
- Governance structure for ESG and climate-related disclosures
- Data collection, report drafting, timeline
- Workshops - ESG materiality assessment, SDGs mapping, sector-specific KPIs and alignment with international standards

- Holders of Bachelor's or higher degrees; or
- Full-time or part-time students leading to bachelor's or higher degrees

## Navigating Shareholder Disputes: Best Practices in the Cayman Islands and BVI

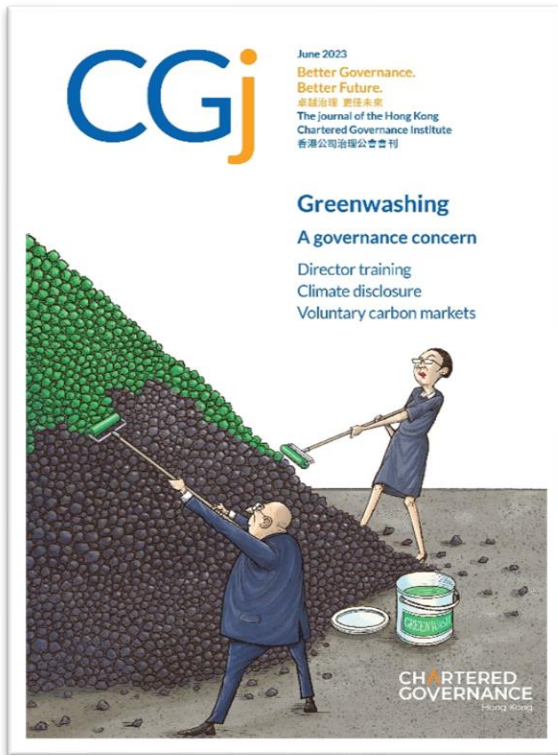
