

There is no doubt that Hong Kong continually seeks to innovate and expand its product offerings. Special Purpose Acquisition Companies (SPACs) are one of the recent initiatives. The governance professional should be aware of developments affecting the choice of investment vehicles and litting regulations. This guidance note (Part 1) is therefore intended to advance the knowledge of the governance professional and as a stocktake of where we are with SPAC, which is a funded shell, pending a de-SPAC transaction where retail investors come in more akin to a traditional IPO.

In December 2021, the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong
Limited (Exchange) amounced the introduction of
Chapter 188 to establish a new SPAC listing regime
to enhance the competitiveness of Hong Kong as
international financial centre and drive potential M&A
opportunities in the Asia Pacific region.





There will be two sessions (2.5-hour workshops) and a take-home mock examination paper under these parts. In part three, students who have attended parts one and two and submitted their answers to the mock examination paper will receive feedback and guidance on how to answer the mock questions.


