Studentship registration (Collaborative Course Agreement (CCA) programme entry)

The updated policy on the CCA late studentship application is applicable to all CCA students commence their CCA programme study from 1 July 2024 and onwards.

Current policy

(applicable to CCA students commence CCA programme study on or before 30 June 2024)

Studentship registration or re-registration made after three months from the commencement of the CCA programme, a late studentship registration application charge of HKD700 per month shall be imposed from the fourth month on a monthly basis until he/she registers as an HKCGI student during the course of study.

New policy

(applicable to CCA students commence CCA programme study on or after 1 July 2024)

Students of the CCA programme who registered or re-registered as HKCGI students three months after the commencement of the CCA programme are subject to payment of CCA studentship late registration charges from the fourth month until they register or re-register as HKCGI students during their CCA programme study, including:

- i. an administrative charge for the applicable financial year for ALL late CCA studentship applications, and
- ii. an additional application charge for CCA studentship from the seventh month after the commencement of the CCA programme.

The late application charge rates are as follows:

25th to 36th months	Four times the studentship
	registration fee
37th months and	Five times the studentship
