The Hong Kong Chartered Governance Institute (HKCGI), formerly known as The Hong Kong Institute of Chartered Secretaries (HKICS), is the only qualifier of the internationally recognised Chartered Secretary and Chartered Governance Professional qualifications in Hong Kong and the Mainland of China.

With over 70 years of history and as the China Division of The Chartered Governance Institute (CGI), the Institute's reach and professional recognition extends to all of CGI's nine divisions, with more than 40,000 members and students worldwide. HKCGI is the fastest growing Division of CGI, with a current membership of over 7,000, 300 graduates and 2,600 students, with significant representations within listed companies and other cross industry governance functions.

Believing that better governance leads to a better future, HKCGI's mission is to promote good governance in an increasingly complex world and to advance leadership in the effective governance and efficient administration of commerce, industry and public affairs. ### What is a Chartered Governance Professional

Over the past two decades, the number of listed companies has grown significantly in Hong Kong and the Mainland of China (the Mainland). In parallel, the business environment has become more complex with listed companies expected to navigate geopolitical tensions, climate-related changes, rising inequalities, cybersecurity risks, technological disruption, challenging stakeholder demands and an increasingly onerous regulatory environment. In Hong Kong, the proposed new requirements in Hong Kong's Corporate Governance Code, published by Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Ltd (HKEX), call for boards to align company culture with company purpose, value and strategy. Governance professionals have an essential role in assisting their organisations to respond to this myriad of challenges, including working with boards of directors to define the long-term purpose of their organisations and align their culture with that purpose.

Under these trends, the importance of good governance, not only for the sustainability of commercial and not-for-profit organisations but also for the capital markets and the societies within which they operate, has gained increasing recognition. The Hong Kong Chartered Governance Institute, The Chartered Governance Institute's Hong Kong/China Division, has been implementing a repositioning exercise to better reflect the broadened role of Chartered Secretaries and Chartered Governance Professionals. This led to the launch in 2019 of the dual qualification of Chartered Secretary and Chartered Governance Professional (CS/CGP), and the launch in 2020 of a new qualifying programme – the Chartered Governance Qualifying Programme (CGQP).





The Listing Rules and the Code make it clear that Company Secretaries are key governance advisers to the board and are responsible for updating the board on the latest laws and regulations relevant to the company. Experienced governance professionals make excellent candidates for board postings and often go on to become Chairmen, Chief Executives and Directors. There is a broad spectrum of roles within governance professionals to choose from, including but not limited to:

Company Secretary

Governance Advisers Senior Management in Risk and Compliance

Executive and Non-executive Director

Chief Executive and Board Chairman

### Your Route to HKCGI Membership

Your route to membership of HKCGI starts with a recognised academic or professional qualification. University graduates in all disciplines are eligible to apply as HKCGI students to complete the Chartered Governance Qualifying Programme(CGQP).

The CGQP is an internationally recognised programme with the curriculum developed by The Chartered Governance Institute(CGI) and adopted by HKCGI to meet local needs and applications. Students who have successfully completed the CGQP will be admitted as graduates of CGI and HKCGI.

Graduates who have gained the required work experience may apply to be elected as an Associate or Fellow. Upon successful election, they will have dual membership of CGI and HKCGI, and also be awarded the dual designation of Chartered Secretary (CS) and Chartered Governance Professional (CGP). Both the CS and CGP qualifications are internationally recognised and transportable.

## **Chartered Governance Qualifying Programme Exemptions**

Holders of relevant recognised university degrees and/or professional qualifications will be eligible for module exemption upon assessment by HKCGI. Relevant qualifications include law, accounting, finance, management and corporate governance.
